Educational and Recreational Opportunities:

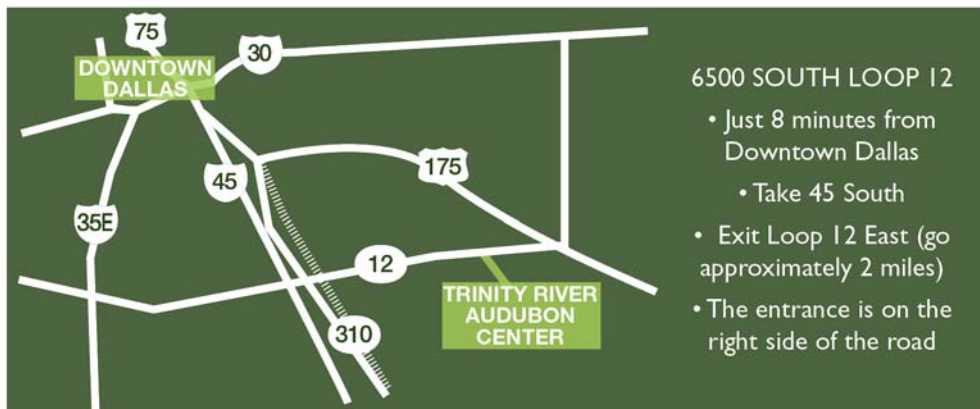
- Hike four miles of trails through restored prairie, wetland and bottomland forest habitats
